O P I N I O N

J. H. Jacobs has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Sacramento and Winters.

A public hearing was conducted by Examiner Handford at Sacramento on March 5th, 1919, the matter was duly submitted and is now ready for decision.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of at least one round trip per day between Sacramento and Winters serving also the intermediate community at Davis and using as equipment one Federal automobile truck two tons rated capacity, 30 H. P., licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 269645, also one trailer three tons capacity, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 94.

Applicant has purchased the route formerly operated

by one R. A. Senf and now desires to arrange his operation in conformity with the provisions of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, and the regulations of the Railroad Commission.

Applicant has secured and filed with the Commission permits from the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo, the City Commission of the City of Sacramento and the Boards of Trustees of the Towns of Davis and Winters.

The service to be rendered by the applicant is a continuance of that formerly in effect by R. A. Senf over the same route and at the hearing on this application no protest was received against the granting of the desired certificate.

O R D E R

J. H. Jacobs having petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Sacramento and Winters and intermediate points, a public hearing having been held, and the matter having been duly submitted and the Commission being fully advised.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by J. H. Jacobs of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight between Sacramento and Winters and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
