O R D E R

Peter Larsen has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage service as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Isabella and Onyx and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip, daily except Sunday, serving as intermediate the community at Weldon and using as equipment one Ford touring car, 22 H. P., five passenger capacity, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under license No. 126480.

Applicant holds a contract for the carriage of United States mail over the route herein proposed and desires the privilege of carrying passengers and freight in conjunction with his mail contract.

A permit has been issued by the Board of Supervisors of Kern County in accordance with the provisions of Section 3, Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, as evidenced by a copy of same filed

with the application in this proceeding.

There is no other regular transportation available for the public over the route herein sought and we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Peter Larsen of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Isabella and Onyx and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be assigned nor transferred unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such assignment or transfer has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
