O R D E R

SAN DIEGO AND ARIZONA RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation,
having, on March 7, 1919, applied to this Commission for an order
approving and authorizing a lease, dated February 28, 1919, in
which said railway company leases to the San Diego Electric Railway
Company, for and during an undetermined period, subject to cancel-
lation upon thirty days' written notice of either party to the other,
a certain short portion of railway tracks and appurtenances located
in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California,
described in said lease and shown on a map accompanying same, copies
of said lease and map being attached to the application and marked
Exhibits "C" and "B" respectively; and it appearing to the Commission
that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That the SAN DIEGO AND ARIZONA RAILWAY
COMPANY be and the same is hereby authorized to execute a lease of a
certain portion of railway tracks and appurtenances in the City of
San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, in the form
marked Exhibit "C" and as shown on the map marked Exhibit "A", both

of which are attached to the application in this proceeding; said lease to be executed upon the following conditions, viz.:

(1) The amounts stated in said agreement as consideration for the lease are not to be taken before this Commission, or any other body, as representing the value of said tracks and appurtenances for rate-fixing or other purposes.

(2) It must be understood that the Commission reserves the right to, at any time, make any orders and impose any further conditions which it deems proper with reference to the matters covered in this lease.
