BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

W. B. Gelatt has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and baggage between Truckee, California, and Donner Lake, California and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit A and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of three round trips daily using as equipment one combined passenger and freight automobile.

Applicant proposes to establish service to care for the transportation of persons and property to a new resort or summer camp about to be established at Donner Lake by the Donner Lake Company, there being no regular transportation at present existing to such proposed resort.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application


should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by W. B. Gelatt of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and baggage between Truckee and Donner Lake; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said W. B. Gelatt shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said W. B. Gelatt has filed herein certified copy of permit issued by the Board of Supervisors of Nevada County in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
