Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has made application for permission to abandon and remove 5,744 linual feet of single track, five turnouts and overhead, formerly used to serve the San Dimas Quarry Company, said track being located on the Covina-San Dimas Quarry Canyon Line, on the applicants Northern Division and in the County of Los Angeles, the track proposed to be removed being shown on a blue print map marked M.W.H. 3150 and identified as exhibit A and filed with the application in this proceeding.

In investigation having been made and it appearing that the track proposed to be abandoned has not been used for a period of some two years preceding the date of application and that there is no prospect of the track serving any public interest, we are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted and,
