FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that in accordance with the order heretofore made in this proceeding on March 12, 1919, SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY has filed a stipulation duly authorized by its Board of Directors, declaring that neither said company, its successors nor assigns will ever claim before the Railroad Commission, or any court, or other public body, a value for the rights and privileges granted in Ordinance Number 515, New Series, of the County of Los Angeles, adopted May 13, 1918, in excess of the actual cost of acquiring such rights and privileges, which cost is stated to be \$234.23.
