FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, Condition No. 3 of the order in Decision Number 6105, dated February 13, 1919, provides that the authority granted in said order shall apply only to such conveyance as may be executed within 60 days after the date of said decision; and

WHEREAS, the agreement of sale covering the properties referred to in the order in Decision Number 6105 permits the purchaser to pay for the properties in monthly installments of \$50 or more, such payments to be made on the 10th day of each and every month beginning January 10, 1919; and

WHEREAS, applicants report that the instrument of conveyance will not be finally executed until the property has been fully paid for;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition No. 3 of the order in Decision No. 6105, dated February 13, 1919, be, and it is hereby, modified so as to permit the transfer of the properties, described in said order, pursuant to the terms and conditions of the agreement of sale filed in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision

Number 6105, dated February 13, 1919, shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
