ORDER EXTENDING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Southern Pacific Company and Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, defendants in the proceeding entitled as above, have filed with this Commission applications for extension of the effective date of the Commission's decision from the 27th day of April, 1912, to the 27th day of May, 1912, which applications allege that Petitioners have been and are diligently prosecuting the work of preparing for publication the tariffs necessary to give lawful effect to said order, but that because of the voluminous character of the tariffs, which will cover about eleven hundred pages of typewritten matter, it has been impossible to complete the said tariffs by said 27th day of April, 1912, and that it will take thirty days within which to complete the preparation for publication of said tariffs.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the effective date of the Commission's decision in the case entitled as above be and the same is hereby extended to the 27th day of May, 1912, at which time said defendants will be expected to file their tariffs in accordance with the Commission's said decision.
