SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS; Sacramento Gas Company reports that it has on deposit with Anglo-California Trust Company, Trustee; unexpended funds amounting to \$6,391.36, obtained from the sale of bonds, the issue of which was authorized by Decision Number 2898, dated November 13, 1915; and

WHEREAS; Sacramento Gas Company reports it will be able to pay for all necessary additions and betterments during the next three years without drawing upon said deposit for more than \$2,391.36, and therefore requests permission to invest \$4,000.00 in United States Government 4-3/4 per cent Victory Loan Notes;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sacramento Gas Company  
be, and it is hereby, authorized to invest in United States Govern-  
ment 4-3/4 per cent Victory Loan Notes in the sum of \$4,000.00

notes to be deposited with Anglo-California Trust Company, Trustee,  
and the interest thereon to be added to the principal of the fund.
