O R D E R

By the Commission.

SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY, a corporation,
having on May 1, 1913, filed with the Commission an application for
permission to move the crossing of a house track at grade across Sixth
Street, Town of Dos Palos, Merced County, California, as hereinafter
indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case
in which a public hearing is necessary, that it is not reasonable nor
practicable to avoid a grade crossing with said street, and that
the application should be granted, subject to the conditions hereinafter
specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted Southern
Pacific Company to move the present crossing at grade of its house track
across Sixth Street, town of Dos Palos, Merced County, California, on
the west side of its main track from a point about twenty (20) feet west
of said track to a distance of seventy-seven (77) feet, as shown by the
map attached to the application, and subject to the following conditions
viz.:

- (1) The entire expense of constructing the crossing, together
with the cost of its maintenance hereinafter in good and first-class con-
dition for the safe and convenient use of the public shall be borne by
applicant.
- (2) Said crossing shall be constructed of a width (parallel with
the track) of not less than thirty-six (36) feet, with grades of approach

of not less than twenty (20) feet on each side of the track.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
