BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WESTERN STATES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY having filed with the Railroad Commission a statement showing that during February and March, 1919, it has expended for construction purposes the sum of \$56,728.95, and it appearing that the sum so expended was for proper capital purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that WESTERN STATES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY be, and it is hereby, granted authority to withdraw cash deposited with the trustee pursuant to the order in Decision Number 6117, dated February 13, 1919 in an amount equivalent to the proceeds realized from the sale of \$42,546.71 of bonds, said bonds being equal to 75 per cent of applicant's expenditures on capital account during February and March, 1919.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 6117, dated February 13, 1919 as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
