ORDER OF DISMISSAL

R. A. Barnett, J. Lynch and M. D. Jones, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Eastern Truck Line, have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by them of an automobile freight line as a common carrier of freight and express between Oakland, Pleasanton, Livermore and intermediate points.

Public hearings on this application were set at San Francisco on April 26th and May 24th, 1919. At the time and place set for hearings on this application there was no representation on behalf of applicants herein, although protestants appeared at each hearing to oppose the granting of the application. In view of the fact that applicants made no appearance at the public hearings set in this matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is dismissed.
