ORDER

E. E. Tremain has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity requires the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, packages, and property between the communities at Crockers and Carlin in the County of Tuolumne.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application herein and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily with terminals at the Crocker Hotel at Crockers and at the Carlin Hotel at Carlin, using as equipment one G. M. C. automobile, twenty eight horsepower, with a seating capacity of eleven persons.

There is no regular transportation at present existing between the points covered by the route for which certificate is herein sought, and it is the intention of the applicant to extend an existing line from Groveland to Crockers to make a connection at Carlin with the stage line operated by the Yosemite National

Park Company.

The Commission is of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by E. E. Tremain of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, packages and other property between Crocker and Carlin in the County of Tuolumne; provided, however, that this declaration shall not become effective until said E.E. Tremain shall have secured from the Railroad Commission a supplemental order herein reciting that said E. E. Tremain has filed herein a certified copy of a permit granted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tuolumne in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917; and provided, further, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment will have first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
