FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA has filed a stipulation as provided in the order heretofore made in this proceeding on May 29, 1919, in which stipulation said SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA agrees that the difference between the proceeds from the sale of \$620,000 of its first mortgage bonds and the purchase price of \$825,000 paid by it for the gas properties of Southern California Edison Company and Santa Barbara Gas and Electric Company, referred to in the Commission's decision of May 29, 1919, will be paid by the stockholders of the Southern Counties Gas Company of California through the appropriation of surplus earnings.
