IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company may issue and sell at not less than \$85.00 per share, on or before December 31, 1919, 2,122 shares (\$212,200) of its 6 per cent first preferred stock authorized to be issued in Decision Number 3023, dated January 3, 1916, (Vol. 9, Opinions and Orders of the Railroad Commission of California, Page 9).

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this Commission's Order in Decision Number 3023, dated January 3, 1916, and such orders as have been issued supplemental thereto, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Fifth Supplemental Order.
