BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railroad, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of service and abandonment of its street railway line in the city of Marysville more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the west property line of "A" street with 6th street in the city of Marysville, thence extending west to the intersection of 6th and "C" streets, Marysville, thence extending south along and upon said "C" street to a point between 2nd and 3rd street, said point of termination being at Engineer's Station 6 plus 47.

The reasons for the requested discontinuance of service and removal of track are a duplication of service existing on "D" street which is but one block from the track proposed to be abandoned; the lack of patronage over the portion of the track herein proposed to be abandoned and a resolution of the Common Council of the city of Marysville at its regular meeting on June 2, 1919, directing the applicant herein to at once remove its railroad tracks from "C" street and 6th street along the route hereinabove described, such resolution being referred to in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission is of the opinion that the abandonment and removal of trackage, as herein sought, is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
