Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation having applied to this Commission for a certificate that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of the rights and privileges granted to applicant by the City of Eagle Rock, in its Ordinance No. 71, N.S., adopted March 10, 1913, by which ordinance applicant is given the right to construct and maintain a system of gas pipes in and along all the public streets of the City of Eagle Rock, and Southern California Gas Company, which is also operating in the City of Eagle Rock, having filed with the Commission its written consent to the granting of this application, and the Commission being of the opinion that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED That public convenience and necessity require the exercise by the Los Angeles Gas and Electric Corporation of the rights and privileges granted to said corporation by the City of Eagle Rock, in its Ordinance No. 71, N.S.
