## ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied for authority to abandon its Blue Tent Canal and that portion of its Rock Creek Canal from the point of commencement down to where said canal enters the Northeast quarter of Section 6, T. 16 N, R. 9 E.,

Applicant alleges that neither of said canals has been used for some time past and is not now being used by applicant for the conveyance of water; that there is no person, firm or corporation possessed of any right or rights to demand or receive water service for any purpose whatsoever from applicant, to be supplied through its said Blue Tent Canal or said Rock Creek Canal; that both said Canals are in more or less a depreciated condition and cannot be economically used for the conveyance of water; that said Rock Creek Canal and said Blue Tent Canal are not now used or useful and have not for some time past been used or useful to applicant in its public utility business of generating and selling electric energy or in its business of supplying water for domestic, irrigation or other purposes.

It appearing to the Railroad Commission that a public hearing in the above entitled matter is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the application be and the same is hereby granted.
