ORDER

San Francisco-Oakland Terminal Railways, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of a portion of its street railway system located in the City of Oakland and more particularly described as follows:

"Commencing at the point of intersection of the center line of Thirteenth Avenue with the center line of East Eleventh Street and running thence northeasterly along the center line of Thirteenth Avenue to the center line of East Twenty-second Street, thence easterly by the most practicable curves and tangents over and across the Block numbered one hundred and forty as the same is delineated and so designated upon Higley's Map of the Town of Clinton, and to a point on or near the southern line of East Twenty-third Street at or near its intersection at that place with the strip of land above referred to "

For the reason that the operation of street cars over the route hereinabove described is no longer necessary for the accommodation of the patrons of the applicant, the Council of the City of Oakland has, by its Ordinance No. 1661 N.S. under date July 23, 1919, accepted the abandonment and surrender to

the City of Oakland of all rights and privileges heretofore conferred by franchise as regards the portion of the line hereinabove referred to, said franchise having been granted under Ordinance No. 1493 passed January 12, 1893 and approved January 17, 1893, as evidenced by certified copy of Ordinance No. 1661 N.S. attached to the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
