O R D E R

J. A. Keithly, as proprietor of the Konocti Freight Line, has applied to the Railroad Commission for permission to transfer by sale to J. R. Huston the automobile freight line heretofore operated by said Keithly between Hopland, California, and Kelseyville, California, and intermediate points, and J. R. Huston has applied for permission to purchase such operative rights in accordance with a bill of sale under date of August 4, 1919, attached to the application in this proceeding.

The Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted subject, however, to the following conditions:

First that the transfer herein authorized shall not be effective until said J. E. Keithly will have withdrawn and cancelled all tariffs and scheduled filings now of record with this Commission and said J. R. Huston will have filed tariffs

and schedules with this Commission in accordance with its rules and regulations and the provisions of General Order No. 51.
