BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

O. N. Pauly and J. E. Pauly, partners in business, have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by them of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Marysville and Downieville and intermediate points.

Applicants propose to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip daily, except Sundays, serving as intermediate points the communities at Goodyear, Ballard's Bar, Camptonville, Dobbins, Oregon House and Browns Valley; using as equipment three five passenger automobile stages and horse stages during the winter months.

There is no other regular transportation service over the route herein sought and applicants, who are the possessors of a United States mail contract, desire the privilege of handling passengers and freight over the route which they are

required to serve in connection with their mail contract.

The Commission being fully advised and of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by O. N. Pauly and J. E. Pauly, partners in business, of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers and freight between Marysville and Downieville and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
