SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 6544, dated August 7, 1919, authorized SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY to issue 25,000 shares of its common capital stock at not less than \$90.00 per share to its stockholders, or to the public; and

WHEREAS, Southern California Edison Company now asks permission to sell 5,000 shares of said 25,000 share to its employes, officers and department heads, 298 shares of said 5,000 shares to be sold to officers and department heads; and

WHEREAS, applicant asks permission to sell the 5,000 shares of stock pursuant to the terms of the subscription agreement attached to the first supplemental petition in the above entitled matter and marked Exhibit "A", and pursuant to the terms of the subscription agreement marked Exhibit "A" attached to the Third Supplemental Petition in Application No. 2743; and

WHEREAS, applicant reports that it will sell none of the 5,000 shares of stock at less than \$90.00 per share, and it appearing to the Commission that applicant's request should be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to sell to its employes 4702 shares and to its officers and department heads 298 shares of the stock authorized to be issued by Decision No. 6544, dated August 7, 1919, said stock to be sold for not less than \$90.00 per share, and in all other respects in accordance with the agreement marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the first supplemental petition in Application No. 4790, and the agreement marked Exhibit "A" and attached to the third supplemental petition in Application No. 2743.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 6544, dated August 7, 1919, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Second Supplemental Order.
