ORDER

SAN FERNANDO MISSION LAND COMPANY having asked authority to lease and subsequently sell to the City of Los Angeles, in accordance with the provisions of an indenture made the 17th day of July, 1919, a copy of which is attached to the application herein and marked "Exhibit B," the following described property:

- (a) All water rights, wells, pipe lines, service connections, meters, appliances, appurtenances and extensions constituting and pertaining to the water system as constructed, operated and maintained by the said San Fernando Mission Land Company, and now owned by it, and located within the corporate limits of said City of San Fernando, and in territory adjacent thereto; said property being more particularly described and set forth in the deed of conveyance hereto attached and marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

(b) All franchises and rights-of-way and land owned and held by said first party, and used or necessary in connection with the construction, maintenance or operation of said water distributing system.

(c) All maps and records pertaining to said water system, as above described, and relating to said pipes, service, consumers, property, rates, etc.

and the City of Los Angeles having joined in said application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application herein be and the same hereby is granted, provided that this authority shall apply only to such transfers as shall be made on or before December 31, 1920.
