ORDER

GEORGE H. PECK, owner of a water system and engaged in the business of supplying water for domestic and irrigation purposes through and by means of said water system in that part of the City of Los Angeles known as San Pedro, and more particularly described in the application herein, having made application to transfer said system to the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles, and the Board of Public Service Commissioners of the City of Los Angeles having joined in said application, a public hearing having been held, and it appearing that public convenience and necessity will be conserved by the granting of said application,--

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application be and the same is hereby granted upon the following conditions, and not otherwise:

(1) The consideration given for the water system herein authorized to be transferred shall not be considered as a measure of value of said property before this Commission or any other public body for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

(2) Within thirty (30) days after the execution by petitioners herein of an instrument of conveyance transferring the properties herein referred to, a certified copy of said instrument of conveyance shall be filed with the Railroad Commission by George H. Peck.

(3) The authority herein granted to transfer property shall apply only to such transfer as may have been made on or before December 31, 1919.

(4) Within ten (10) days of the date of transfer, a written statement signed by petitioners herein shall be filed with this Commission, indicating that such transfer has taken place.
