BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

F. M. DINSMORE has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage, express and freight between Ravensdale and Glade and intermediate points.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of one round trip on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays of each week serving as intermediate the community at Red Rock, using as equipment one Ford Model T Roadster with delivery body; twenty-two and one half horse power with carrying capacity of two passengers and 800 pounds of freight; licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under License No. 558502.

Applicant is the possessor of a United States mail contract over the route herein sought and desires, in connection

with the carriage of United States mail to carry such limited passenger, express and freight traffic that may offer by the public, there being no other regular method of transportation available over the route herein sought.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by F. M. Dinsmore of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage, express and freight between Ravendale and Glade and intermediate points; provided, however, that the rights and privileges herein granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
