BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Dr. C. W. Sylvester, owner of the Riverview Water Company, engaged in the business of selling water for domestic and garden purposes in Los Angeles, California, having made application for authority to discontinue such service, a public hearing having been held, and it appearing that arrangements have been made whereby the consumers of the Riverview Water Company will receive their water supply from another source, and that public convenience and necessity will be conserved by the granting of said application,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted upon the following conditions, and not otherwise:

- (1) Applicant shall file with this Commission a

statement releasing him from the service of supplying water for domestic purposes, said statement to be signed by all consumers.

(2) Applicant shall not discontinue the service of water to consumers until such time as said service is supplied from another source.

(3) Within ten days of the time when service is discontinued as herein authorized, applicant shall file a written statement with this Commission indicating that water service has been discontinued in accordance with the terms of this order.
