ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This complainant seeks establishment of through joint rates on lumber and other freight between points on defendant's Albion Branch and San Francisco in connection with water carriers.

By supplemental answer, defendant denies jurisdiction of the Commission, owing to that road having passed under federal control. This question having been definitely disposed of by decision of the U.S. Supreme Court in Northern Pacific Railway Company, et al. vs. the State of North Dakota, et al., and this Commission being without jurisdiction in the premises, the case will be dismissed.

ORDER

This Commission having no jurisdiction in the above

entitled proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the same be and it is hereby dismissed.
