

Decision No. 676

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the application of Halfmoon Bay Light and Power Company, a corporation, for permission to increase capitalization.

Application No. 166.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This Commission having on October 3, 1912, made an order in this proceeding, authorizing applicant to increase its capital stock from \$25,000.00 to \$100,000.00, and authorizing the issuance of all of this stock upon certain conditions, and providing that the proceeds derived from the sale of this stock should be applied to certain purposes specified in said order: and Halfmoon Bay Light and Power Company having applied to this Commission for a modification of the order made October 3, 1912, so as to permit applicant to use a portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the stock therein authorized to be issued, to reimburse applicant for moneys expended from income during the past year for purposes properly capitalizable, to the amount of \$1,165.05; and it appearing to the Commission that this application should be granted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Halfmoon Bay Light and Power Company be, and it is hereby authorized to use the proceeds derived from the sale of stock authorized to be issued by this Commission's order in this proceeding made on October 3, 1912, to reimburse the treasury of applicant to the amount of \$1,165.05, which amount has been expended by applicant from income during the past year.

for purposes properly capitalizable, the authority herein granted being otherwise subject to all the conditions set forth in this Commission's order made on October 3, 1912.
