BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

CASCADA AND HUNTINGTON LAKE STAGE COMPANY, a co-  
partnership, composed of E. C. Tripp, Sr., R. W. Tripp, E. M.  
and  
Tripp, /E. C. Tripp, Jr., have petitioned the Railroad Commission  
for authority to sell and transfer and Huntington Lake Hotel  
Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission  
for authority to purchase and acquire the operative rights here-  
tofore held by Cascada and Huntington Lake Stage Company, a co-  
partnership, over the route between Cascada and Huntington Lake.

This application is brought under the provisions of  
Section 5 of Chapter 213, Laws of 1917, as amended by Chapter  
280, Laws of 1919, amendments becoming effective July 22, 1919,  
such statutory enactment requiring the approval by the Railroad  
Commission to transfers of operative rights as herein sought.

The operative rights herein sought to be transferred  
are those acquired by Cascada and Huntington Lake Stage Company,

a co-partnership, under the provisions of Decision No. 5356 on Application No. 3680 before this Commission decided April 30, 1918 .

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted under the following conditions:

1 - All tariffs and time schedules now on file with this Commission under the name of Cascada and Huntington Lake Stage Company, a co-partnership, shall be cancelled in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of this Commission.

2 - Applicant, Huntington Lake Hotel Company, a corporation, shall either adopt as their own or file new time and rate schedules similar to those heretofore of record in the name of Cascada and Huntington Lake Stage Company, a co-partnership

3 - The rights and privileges, transfers of which are hereby authorized, shall not again be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfers or assignments has first been secured.

4 - No vehicle shall be operated by applicants,  
Huntington Lake Hotel Company, a corporation, unless such vehicle  
is owned by such applicants or is leased under a contract or  
agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
