O R D E R

L. P. Delano, being the owner of a small domestic water system supplying the inhabitants of Carmelien Bay, Placer County, California, having asked authority to transfer to Wm. L. Govan all of said water system more particularly described in the application, and Wm. L. Govan having joined in the application, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application, and the same is hereby granted upon the following conditions:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of said water system shall not be taken as necessarily representing the value of said system for rate-fixing purposes.
2. The authority herein granted to transfer said system shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before December 31, 1919.

3. That certified copy of deed transferring property of applicants be filed with this Commission.
4. Within ten days subsequent to date of transfer that statement be filed with this Commission indicating that such transfer has taken place.
