

## BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the Application of the Western Realty Company, a corporation, for authority to sell, and of W. T. Virgin and C. D. Ter-williger for authority to purchase, a water system in the town of Loyalton, County of Sierra, State of California.

## ORDER

Western Realty Company, owner of a water system supplying domestic water to a few consumers in the vicinity of the Town of Loyalton, Sierra County, California, having asked authority to transfer to W. T. Virgin and C. D. Terwilliger all of said water system more particularly described in the application and W. T. Virgin and C. D. Terwilliger having joined in the application and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, and that the application should be granted;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be, and the same is hereby granted upon the following conditions:

1.- The consideration for the transfer of said water system shall not be taken as necessarily representing the value of said system for rate fixing purposes.

2.- The authority herein granted to transfer said system shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before December 31, 1919.

5.- W.T. Virgin and C.D. Terwilliger within thirty days after the acquisition of the properties herein referred to shall advise the Commission that they have acquired the properties and file with the Commission a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance under which they have acquired the properties.
