Decision No. 6804

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application
of J. W. POST, Jr., for certificate
of public convenience and
necessity to operate stage or
truck service between Monterey,
California, and Big Sur, Calif-
ornia. Application No. 4868.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

J. W. POST, Jr., has petitioned the Railroad Commission
for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity
require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a
common carrier of passengers, freight and express between
Monterey, California, and Big Sur, California.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with
a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application
in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of three round
trips per week leaving Monterey on Mondays, Wednesdays and
Fridays, and Big Sur on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays,
using as equipment one Oldsmobile three-quarter ton truck,
equipped to carry seven passengers or 1500 pounds of freight,
also one Buick automobile truck, three-quarter ton capacity,
equipped to carry five passengers, licensed by State Motor
Vehicle Department under License No. 420281.

Applicant is the possessor of a United States mail con-
tract over the route herein sought and desires to carry in con-
nection with the transportation of United States mail such
passenger, express and freight traffic as may offer over the

route herein sought, there being no other regular transportation available.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by J. E. Post, Jr., of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, express and freight between Monterey and Big Sur, California; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby granted may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured; and provided, further, that the operating rules and safety regulations of the Railroad Commission relating to automobile stage and truck operation shall in all instances be strictly observed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this certificate unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant on a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY reserves the right to cancel, at its option, with or without hearing as it may elect, the operative rights herein conferred by this certificate of public convenience and necessity, if complaints are received regarding the manner in which the line herein authorized is conducted.
