O R D E R

P. T. Durfy, owner of a water system and engaged in the business of supplying water for domestic purposes through and by means of said water system to consumers in Sherman, Los Angeles County, said system and property being more particularly described in the application herein, having made application to transfer said system to W. P. Cunningham and F. B. R. Cunningham, and W. P. Cunningham and F. B. R. Cunningham having joined in the application and a public hearing having been held, and it appearing that public convenience and necessity will be conserved by the granting of this application.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and the same is hereby granted upon the following conditions, and not otherwise:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of said water system shall not be taken as necessarily representing the value of said system for rate fixing purposes.
2. The authority herein granted to transfer

said system shall apply only to such transfer as may be made on or before December 31, 1919.

3. A certified statement shall be filed with the Commission by W. P. Cunningham and F. B. R. Cunningham not later than 30 days subsequent to the date of transfer, indicating that such transfer has taken place.

4. A certified copy of deed transferring property herein authorized to be transferred shall be filed with the Commission within 10 days of the date of such transfer by W. P. Cunningham and F. B. R. Cunningham.
