BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

J. W. Walker and E. C. Sedgwick have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing said J. W. Walker to sell and transfer and said E. C. Sedgwick to purchase and acquire and hereafter operate an automobile stage line between Sacramento and Vacaville and intermediate points.

The proposed transfer is to be made in accordance with a certain agreement and bill of sale, a copy of which has been furnished to the Railroad Commission and is attached as exhibit "A" to the application in this proceeding.

The operative rights proposed to be transferred are those authorized by this Commission by Decision No. 5633 on Application No. 3685 as decided July 26, 1918.

We believe that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted upon the following conditions:

1 - Applicant, J. W. Walker will be required to immediately cancel all tariff and time schedule filings now of record with this Commission in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

2 - Applicant, T. C. Sedgwick, will be required to either adopt as his own or file in his individual name tariffs and schedules similar to those formerly on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of J. W. Walker. Tariff rates to be the same as those heretofore of record in the filings of J. W. Walker.

3 - The rights and privileges, the transfer of which is hereby authorized, may not again be transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4 - No vehicle may be operated by applicant, T. C. Sedgwick, under this authority of transfer unless such vehicle is owned by such applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
