O R D E R

WHEREAS, White Bus Line, a corporation, asks permission to issue and sell at par to its present stockholders, \$7,443.00, par value of stock and use the proceeds to acquire additional automobile trucks; and

WHEREAS, applicant reports that the purchase of the equipment is made necessary by the increase in its business, and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that White Bus Line be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue and sell at par for cash, on or before March 1, 1920, common stock in the amount of \$7,443.00, provided: -

(1)-That applicant will use the proceeds obtained from the sale of the \$7,443.00 of stock to acquire additional automobile trucks referred to in the petition herein.

(2)-That applicant will keep such record of the issue and sale of the stock herein authorized and of the disposition of the proceeds, as will enable it to file on or before the twenty-fifth day of each month a verified report as required by the Railroad Commission's General Order No. 24, which order, in so far as applicable, is made a part of this Order.
