BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

C. HARAMOTO has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Old River Bridge in the County of San Joaquin, to the Town of Bryon, in the County of Contra Costa, a distance of six miles.

Applicant proposes to charge rates in accordance with a schedule made a portion of the application in this proceeding and to operate on a schedule of four round trips daily; using as equipment two White automobiles, one seven passenger and one twelve passenger capacity, licensed by State Motor Vehicle Department under license numbers 302192 and 153934.

The service proposed by applicant is a continuation of that now rendered by the authority of the Railroad Commission between Stockton and Old River Bridge, via Holt Station and

Victoria Island.

There is no regular means of transportation in the territory sought to be served and we are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by C. Hatamoto of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Old River Bridge, San Joaquin County and Bryon, Contra Costa County; provided, however, that the rights and privileges hereby authorized may not be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no vehicle may be operated under this permit unless such vehicle is owned by the applicant herein or is leased by such applicant on a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
