ORDER

I. W. BAUGHMAN and JAMES LYCKE, partners in business, and W. A. GENTRY have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the sale and transfer of the operative rights and equipment of a certain stage line operated between Vallejo and Sacramento and between Napa and Sacramento Junction from said Lycke and Baughman to said W. A. Gentry, the latter to hereafter operate said stage line.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred are those heretofore granted by the Railroad Commission in its decisions on the following proceedings:

Decision No. 6129 decided February 14, 1919, and supplemental order thereon, Decision No. 6258 decided April 14, 1919, on Application No. 4351.

Decision No. 6481 on Application No. 4685, decided July 3, 1919.

Decision No. 6661 on Application No. 4771, decided September 12, 1919.

A copy of the proposed agreement of sale under which the transfer of equipment and operative rights is to be consummated has been filed with the Railroad Commission and is of record with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted, in accordance with the following conditions:

- I - Applicants, Baughman and Lycke, will be required to immediately cancel in accordance with General Order No. 51 and the regulations of the Railroad Commission, all tariffs and time schedules now filed with the Railroad Commission.
- II - Applicant, W. A. Gentry, will be required to file in his own name or to adopt as his own the time schedules and rates of fare as heretofore filed by applicants, Baughman and Lycke, all rates to be in accordance with those heretofore filed by applicants, Baughman and Lycke.
- III - The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby authorized, may not again be transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been procured.

1V - No vehicle may be operated by the applicant, W. A. Gentry, under the authority covered by this approval of sale and transfer unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant, W. A. Gentry, or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
