FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in Decision Num-
ber 6848, dated November 19, 1919, in the above entitled matter,
authorized Western Motor Transport Company to issue \$40,000.00
of stock to acquired the properties of Oakland Vallejo Transit
Company, a co-partnership; and

WHEREAS, applicant also asks, in the above entitled
matter, permission to issue 1 share of stock, at par, for cash to
each of its 5 incorporators;

AND it appearing to the Railroad Commission that Western Motor Transport Company should be permitted to issue 1 share of stock to each of its five incorporators;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Western Motor Transport Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to issue on or before February 15, 1920, at par, for cash, 1 share (\$100) of stock to each of its incorporators mentioned in the petition herein;

PROVIDED, the \$500.00 received from the issue of the stock, will be used for working capital; and

PROVIDED FURTHER that Western Motor Transport Company will keep such record of the issue and sale of the stock herein authorized and of the disposition of the proceeds, as will enable it to file on or before the twenty-fifth day of each month a verified report as required by the Railroad Commission's General Order No. 24, which order, in so far as applicable, is made a part of this Order.
