BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

ROCCA LAND COMPANY having applied to the Railroad
Commission for authority to transfer to MARIN MUNICIPAL WATER
DISTRICT the following public utility property:

"All water pipes and mains, service connections, meters, hydrants, valves and fixtures composing the distributing system of the party of the first part located on that certain subdivision of land in the County of Marin, State of California, known as Fairfax Heights, and consisting of all of the above described real property located in Rocca Boulevard, Geary Avenue, Marie Avenue, Sadie Lane, Jessi Lane and Alice Lane, as said streets, roads or highways are laid out and delineated on that certain map entitled Map of Fairfax Heights, and which was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Marin, State of California, in Map Book 4, page 28; together with all of the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

"And also the right of way over, along, under, through and across each, all and several of the roads, streets, highways, lanes, avenues and alley-ways laid out and delineated upon the map hereinabove referred to, to lay, maintain, repair, remove, and conduct water pipes, mains, service connections and other appliances for the delivery, distribution and sale of water."

and Marin Municipal Water District having joined in this application, and it appearing to the Railroad Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be, and it is hereby, granted, provided that Rocca Land Company file with the Commission within thirty days after the transfer of the property herein authorized a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance, together with a statement showing the exact date when the transfer was consummated.
