SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That Condition No. 1 of the
order in Decision No. 6863, dated November 24, 1919, be and
the same is hereby amended so as to read:

(1) The cost of constructing the crossing, to-
gether with the cost of its maintenance thereafter
in good and first-class condition, for the safe
and convenient use of the public, shall be borne
by the applicant, subject to such agreement as
it may have entered into with the industry to be
served in accordance with General Order No. 15
of the United States Railroad Administration.
