ORDER DENYING REHEARING.

Defendant having applied for rehearing on the ground that the tank ordered installed in its water system by Decision No. 6382 of June 3, 1919, would not result in increasing its water pressure and that the condition complained of had been effectually remedied by installing three service mains, and requesting further hearing and a modification of the order herein in so far as its relation to storage tanks is concerned, and the Commission's engineers having reported that an investigation has been made by them on the ground in company with the officers and attorney for said defendant and that in their judgment the original order should not be modified; and it appearing to the Commission that no further hearing is required.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petition for rehearing  
be denied and that the original order be promptly  
complied with.
