A. L. Owens and A. C. Maier, co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Oakland-Crockett Messenger and Express Company, have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by them of an automobile truck line as a common carrier of express between Crockett, Contra Costa County, and Oakland, Alameda County, and intermediate points.

A public hearing on this application was conducted by Examiner Handford at San Francisco, the matter was duly submitted and is now ready for decision.

Applicants propose to charge rates in accordance with a schedule marked exhibit "A" and filed with the application in this proceeding and to operate over the state highway one round trip daily, except Sunday and holidays, serving all intermediate communities and towns between termini, using as equipment one Briscoe Automobile delivery truck, one-half ton capacity,
