ORDER

By the Commission.

NORTHERN ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, having on May 22, 1913, filed with the Commission an application for permission to construct its track at grade across Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Streets, where the same intersect "X" Street, in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, as hereinafter indicated, and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a public hearing is necessary, that applicant has secured the necessary franchise or permit from the City Council of the City of Sacramento, authorizing the construction and operation of the proposed track on "X" Street, and it further appearing that it is not reasonable nor practicable to avoid grade crossings with the said streets intersecting "X" Street and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission be hereby granted Northern Electric Railway Company to construct its track on "X" Street, in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, crossing Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Streets, where the same intersect "X" Street, said track to be adjacent to and parallel with a track now owned and operated by applicant on "X" Street, and to serve the purpose and permit the operation of a double track system upon said "X" Street, in said City, in accordance with the petition of applicant, subject to the following conditions, viz.:

- (1) The track shall be constructed in accordance with the requirements and as prescribed by the Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, California, permitting the construction of said track.

(2) The crossings shall be hereafter maintained by the applicant in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said crossings as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.
