O R D E R

O. R. FULLER and White Bus Line Company, a corporation, have petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order approving the terms and conditions of a certain lease of operative rights and equipment from said O. R. Fuller to said White Bus Line Company, a corporation.

The operative rights proposed to be leased together with the necessary equipment for operating same are those heretofore transferred from Will R. Forker, trustee, to applicant O. R. Fuller, such transfer being made in accordance with this Commission's Decision No. 6879 as decided November 28, 1919. A copy of the lease, approval of which is hereby requested, appears as an exhibit marked exhibit "C", and attached to the application in this proceeding and we are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, O. R. Fuller, be and he hereby is authorized to lease to applicant White Bus Line Company, a corporation, all the property and operative rights heretofore acquired by said applicant, O. R. Fuller from Will R. Forker, trustee, under the authority conveyed by this Commission's Decision No. 6879 as decided November 28, 1919, in accordance with the provisions of a certain memorandum of lease dated December 1, 1919, and appearing as exhibit "C" in the application in this proceeding.

The Commission reserves the right to make such other and further orders in this proceeding as to it may seem just and proper or as in its opinion the public convenience and necessity may demand.
