In the Matter of the application of G. E. Mansperger for an order granting permission to transfer and sell all his right, title and interest in auto truck line operated between Los Angeles and Westminster, to James R. Morgan, and for permission to discontinue his service, and application of James R. Morgan for an order granting permission to purchase and operate such auto truck line thereafter.

Application No. 5251.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

G. E. Mansperger and James R. Morgan have applied to the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the sale and transfer of an auto truck line as a common carrier of freight from applicant, G. E. Mansperger, to applicant, James R. Morgan,

The proposed sale and transfer is to be made in accordance with a memorandum agreement between the applicants hereto, copy of which is marked exhibit "A" and attached to the application in this proceeding.

The rights and privileges proposed to be transferred are those authorized by a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 6961 on Application No. 4637, decided December 19, 1919.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

I - Applicant, G. E. Mansperger, will be required to immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules filed with the Railroad Commission, such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51 and other regulations of the Railroad Commission.

II - Applicant, J. R. Morgan, will be required to file in his own name tariffs and time schedule or to adopt as his own the tariffs and time schedules heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant, G. E. Mansperger; all tariff filings to contain rates in accordance with those heretofore filed with the Railroad Commission by applicant, G. E. Mansperger,

III - The rights and privileges, transfer of which are hereby authorized, may not again be transferred or assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such transfer or assignment has first been secured.

IV - No vehicle may be operated under this authorization of transfer by applicant, J. R. Morgan, unless such vehicle is owned by such applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
