FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that, in accordance with the order heretofore made in this proceeding on November 18, 1919, in Decision No. 6844, CALIFORNIA TELEPHONE & LIGHT COMPANY has filed with the RAILROAD COMMISSION, a stipulation duly authorized by its Board of Directors, which stipulation enumerates the franchises under which CALIFORNIA TELEPHONE & LIGHT COMPANY will operate, and declares that neither said company, its successors nor assigns will ever claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body, a value for the rights and privileges granted in Ordinance #152 of the County of Lake, adopted June 5, 1911; Ordinance #183 of the County of Mendocino, adopted June 6, 1911; and Ordinance #186 of the Town of Lakeport, adopted July 3, 1911, in excess of the actual cost thereof, which cost is stated to be

respectively \$20, \$33., and \$50.
