SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission of the State of California, by Decision No. 5730, made on September 3, 1918, made its order providing for the filing by Spring Valley Water Company of monthly statements, beginning on the first day of October, 1918, setting out fully and in detail the results of the application of certain rates established in said decision and,

WHEREAS, it appears that said monthly statements

are no longer required for the purposes of this Commission in the above entitled matters.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Spring Valley Water Company be, and it is hereby authorized to discontinue the filing of monthly statements as above outlined, said authority to become effective on the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 5730, dated September 3, 1918 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified herein and by the Commission's First Supplemental Order, Decision No. 5926, dated November 15, 1918.
