FRESNO TRACTION COMPANY, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of a certain street car track in the City of Fresno, County of Fresno, said track being located on the so-called west Fresno line, and being one track of a double track line located on Fresno Street and extending from a point at the intersection of Kearny Avenue with Fresno Street to the end of Fresno Street at its intersection with California Avenue, as more fully shown on a blue print map filed with the application in this proceeding.

Permission of the Board of Trustees of the City of Fresno for the abandonment of the track hereinabove outlined has been granted by a resolution of the Board of Trustees of the City of Fresno passed at a regular meeting on January 19, 1920, as evidenced by a certified copy of said resolution filed with the application in this proceeding.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
