BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission by Decision No. 6938, dated December 11, 1919, authorized Pickwick Stages, Northern Division, to issue at par, \$20,000 of its common capital stock, subject among others, to the condition that the proceeds from the sale of \$10,000 of stock, be expended only for such purposes as the Railroad Commission may hereafter authorize; and

WHEREAS, applicant in its first supplemental application filed in the above entitled matter on January 30, 1920, asked permission to use this \$10,000 of stock to acquire additional automobile equipment: \$9,000 in payment of four Pierce Arrow seven passenger touring cars; and \$1,000 to be applied on the purchase price of a seven passenger Pierce Arrow Series 3 touring car, all of which are referred to in the petition herein; and

IT APPEARING to the Commission that this supplemental petition should be granted:

NOW WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pickwick Stages, Northern Division, be and it is hereby granted permission to use \$10,000. of stock, the issue of which was authorized by Decision No. 6938 dated December 11, 1919, to pay for the additional automobile equipment described in the first supplemental petition in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 6938 dated December 11, 1919 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this first supplemental order.
