FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS Condition 3 of the order in Decision No. 6978 dated December 19, 1919, provides that Estelle N. Grenke cannot issue the 3-year 7% \$8,000. note authorized by said order until the Commission has approved the proposed mortgage securing the payment of the note: and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed mortgage has been filed with the Commission, and it appearing to be in satisfactory form:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Estelle N. Grenke be and she is hereby authorized to execute a mortgage substantially in the same form as the mortgage filed with the Railroad Commission on January 31, 1920, provided that the approval herein given of such mortgage is for the purpose of this proceeding only and an approval in so far as this Commission has jurisdiction over the terms of the Public Utilities Act, and is not intended as an approval of said mort-

gage as to such other legal requirements to which said mortgage may be subject.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision 6978 dated December 19, 1919 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this first supplemental order.
